Join me on Thursday, May 16th at 7:00 p.m. at the North Toronto Memorial Community Centre for a Town Hall on the Province's Bill 108 and the return of the OMB. If passed by the Province of Ontario, Bill 108 will:

- Bring back the planning powers of the OMB over local development
- Include a “Pay to Slay” provision that would allow developers to eliminate endangered species if they pay a fee
- Dramatically weaken heritage protection
- Reduce development charges and community benefits for developers

Since the City of Toronto has less than 30 days to respond to the dramatic changes proposed in Bill 108, it is vital that the citizens of Toronto know about the impacts of Bill 108 before it is passed.
