## SAVE THE DATE

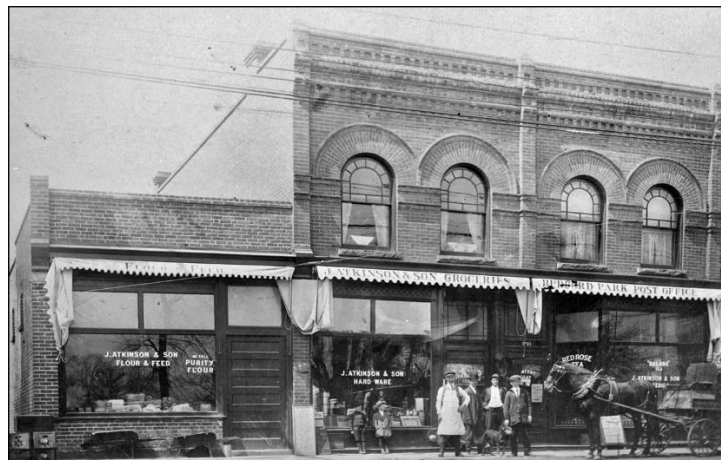
