ActiveTO to be Proactive

Thank you to everyone who submitted comments to us about ActiveTO's Quiet Streets initiative, specifically as it's been implemented on Jedburgh Road.

There were comments in favour, comments opposed, concerns about pedestrian safety and good suggestions for improvements. We relayed all of these to the Councillor's office and ActiveTO. As a result, there have been a number of visits to Jedburgh to tweak the implementation. Each one has made things that much better.



Councillor Colle's office has shared the following note from ActiveTO about how they will be more proactive going forwards, and how you may be able to help keep things flowing as intended:

We (Active TO) have recently started a more proactive patrol regime that should help alleviate some of these concerns, as it will see staff more regularly travel on Quiet Streets to resolve operational issues, like moved barriers. They are also going to mark the road with spray paint where barrels belong per the site plan, and it is hoped that this will help the community understand where they should be placed, if they be moved out of position, and empower them to return them to the proper location."

The spray paint markings on Jedburgh/Duplex will be in place either this week or next week.
